1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the BDFFA
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the BDFFA reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give)
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the BDFFA reclaims you can cancel your declaration (See note 1)
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate of tax you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
